PROCEDURE FOR THE LICENSING AND APPEALS PANEL – SUB COMMITTEE FOR DISCRETIONARY HOUSING APPEALS

- 1. The Council's representative will present the case, the decision which it came to and the reasons for coming to the decision.
- 2. The appellant or their representative will have an opportunity to question the Council's representative.
- 3. Members will have an opportunity to question the Council's representative.
- 4. The appellant or their representative will put forward his or her case.
- 5. The appellant will be questioned by the Council's representative.
- 6. Members will have an opportunity to question the appellant.
- 7. The Council's representative will sum up its case and respond to any points of clarification.
- 8. The appellant or their representative will sum up their case and respond to any points of clarification.
- 9. Parties leave the meeting to allow members to consider their decision. The parties are then recalled and the decision is given.
- 10. If members wish to take further time for deliberations it is quite appropriate to release the persons appearing and confirm a decision later.

There can be variations to this procedure at the discretion of the Chair.
