Decisions to be made in private as a matter of urgency Regulation 5(6)

Where the date by which the meeting must be held makes compliance impractical, the meeting may only be held in private where agreement has been obtained from the Chair of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee. In the event the Chair of the Committee is unable to act, agreement must be obtained from the Mayor.
