

SPECIAL URGENCY ITEM 12 MARCH 2024 FOR THE PERIOD 9 FEBRUARY 2024 TO 30 JUNE 2024

The Chair of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee has been advised of this issue in accordance with regulation 10 and approved for the item to be included within the Cabinet agenda 12 March 2024.

Notice of Intention to take Key Decision without 28-Day Notice. Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that it was impracticable to give 28 days' notice of the taking of the following decision, which is a Key Decision to be taken by the Executive at its meeting on 12 March 2024:

Please be advised that the Chair of Overview and Scrutiny has agreed that the call-in procedure shall not apply to this decision. This is because any delay in implementation caused by the call-in procedure would seriously prejudice the Council's opportunity to comply with the Regulations as detailed below. Accordingly, the Chair of Overview and Scrutiny Committee has agreed that the decision is reasonable in all circumstances, and that it should be treated as a matter of Special Urgency. This is in accordance with the Council Constitution. In order to comply with Regulation 18A of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, as amended by the Neighbourhood Planning (General) and Development Management Procedure (Amendment) Regulations 2016, the date prescribed for the purposes of section 38A(4)(b) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 is the date which is the last day of the period of 8 weeks beginning with the day immediately following that on which the last applicable referendum is held. Therefore, the Council is required to adopt the Cossall Neighbourhood Plan as soon as 'reasonably practicable' after the referendum was held and, in any event, by the end of the period of 8 weeks following the day after the referendum.
