UPDATE IN RELATION TO PROGRESS WITH THE BOROUGH'S NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANS

1. <u>Purpose of report</u>

To provide an update in relation to the progress of Neighbourhood Plans within Broxtowe Borough.

2. Background

Broxtowe Borough Council is currently providing support, assistance and advice to seven Town or Parish Councils and two Neighbourhood Forums in relation to the development of their Neighbourhood Plans. These Neighbourhood Plans are at various stages of preparation from the 'Issues and Options' stage to 'Post-Independent Examination'.

3. <u>Financial implications</u>

The Council can now claim £20,000 from the Ministry of Housing, Communities & Local Government (MHCLG) when it issues a decision statement detailing its intention to send the Neighbourhood Plan to referendum (as set out under Regulation 18 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012) rather than when a referendum date has been set. Up until this point in the process, the Borough Council will need to commit resources and will incur expenses, including but not limited to: the provision of support and assistance; undertaking the Regulation 16 consultation; appointing an Independent Examiner; finalising Neighbourhood Plans and supporting plans and other documents; and organising the referendum.

1 Purpose of report

1.1 To provide an update in relation to the progress of Neighbourhood Plans within Broxtowe Borough.

2. <u>Detail</u>

- 2.1 Broxtowe Borough Council is currently providing support, assistance and advice to seven Town or Parish Councils and two Neighbourhood Forums in relation to the development of their Neighbourhood Plans.
- 2.2 The Independent Examiner's Report has been received for the Awsworth Neighbourhood Plan and approval is sought from this Committee for this Neighbourhood Plan to proceed to referendum; this is the subject of a separate item of this meeting's agenda. One Neighbourhood Plan, the Nuthall Neighbourhood Plan, has been 'made' following a referendum which was held in December 2018.
- 2.3 The key stages of Neighbourhood Plan preparation are as follows:

- 2.5 The Borough Council is working proactively with the Town and Parish Councils and Neighbourhood Forums to provide advice and support to help to progress their Neighbourhood Plans. The assistance being provided includes:
 - Advice in relation to the Neighbourhood Plan process and legislation
 - Assistance in relation to undertaking consultations during lockdown
 - · Provision of contacts for consultation activities
 - Assistance with drafting Neighbourhood Plan policies, aspirations and supporting text

- Suggesting modifications to policies and supporting information to ensure compliance with the 'Basic Conditions' and 'general conformity' with the strategic policies of the Local Plan
- Preparing Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) / Habitats Regulation Assessment (HRA) screening reports
- Providing mapping assistance
- Proof-reading policies, plans, reports and other documents
- Meeting with Town and Parish Councils and Neighbourhood Forums by Microsoft Teams and Zoom
- Providing training and other materials
- Advising upon the Independent Examination stage
- Appointment of Independent Examiners to conduct the Independent Examination
- 2.6 Once a Neighbourhood Plan is formally submitted to the Borough Council following the Regulation 14 consultation, the Borough Council is responsible for undertaking the Regulation 16 consultation of the Neighbourhood Plan and then appointing an Independent Examiner to undertake the Independent Examination. Following the receipt of the Independent Examiner's Report, the Borough Council will be responsible for amending the Plan and arranging the referendum.
- 2.7 The Borough Council expects that a large number of Neighbourhood Plans will be approaching the 'submission' stage within the following year and that several Plans will proceed to the Independent Examination stage later this year and then onwards to referendum.
