

Appendix 1

The image below highlights the potential areas that could have skate parks on them. It takes into potential design considerations of the skate park but also consideration to the existing football pitches and open green spaces taking priority.

The locations also look at potential expansion of pathways on the site linking the two sides through the middle (highlighted in orange). These locations would require further consultation as some will possibly infringe on tree rooting or be in close proximity of residential housing. The red line highlights the current path ways with a new path way included in the middle.

It should also be noted that the entire space highlighted does not have to be skate park but rather it offers insight into the space available and the different locations. The recommended size could be around 360-380m².
