NOTE: You must within 28 days of becoming aware of any changes to the interests specified above provide written notification of the same to the Monitoring Officer.

Registering and declaring pecuniary and non-pecuniary interests

I must, within 28 days of taking office as a member or co-opted member, notify the authority's monitoring officer of any disclosable pecuniary interest as defined by regulations made by the Secretary of State, where the pecuniary interest is mine, my spouse's or civil partner's, or is the pecuniary interest of somebody with whom I am living with as a husband or wife, or as if we were civil partners.

If an interest has not been entered onto the authority's register, then I must disclose the interest to any meeting of the authority at which I am present, where I have a disclosable pecuniary interest in any matter being considered and where the matter is not 'sensitive interest'.¹

Following any disclosure of an interest not on the authority's register or the subject of pending notification, I must notify the monitoring officer of the interest within 28 days beginning with the date of disclosure.

Unless dispensation has been granted, I may not participate in any discussion of, vote on, or discharge any function related to any matter in which I have a disclosable pecuniary interest as defined by regulations made by the Secretary of State.

Additionally, I must observe the restrictions my authority places on my involvement in matters where I have a pecuniary or non-pecuniary interest as defined by my authority.

¹ A 'sensitive interest' is described in the Localism Act 2011 as a member or co-opted member of an authority having an interest, and the nature of the interest being such that the member or co-opted member, and the authorities monitoring officer, consider that disclosure of the details of the interest could lead to the member or co-opted member, or a person connected with the member or co-opted member, being subject to violence or intimidation.
